HOW JESUS' KINGDOM IS SPREAD

After these things the Lord appointed seventy others also, and sent them two by two before His face into every city and place where He Himself was about to go. (2) Then He said to them, "The harvest truly is great, but the laborers are few; therefore pray the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers into His harvest. (3) Go your way; behold, I send you out as lambs among wolves. (4) Carry neither money bag, knapsack, nor sandals; and greet no one along the road. (5) But whatever house you enter, first say, 'Peace to this house.' (6) And if a son of peace is there, your peace will rest on it; if not, it will return to you. (7) And remain in the same house, eating and drinking such things as they give, for the laborer is worthy of his wages. Do not go from house to house. (8) Whatever city you enter, and they receive you, eat such things as are set before you. (9) And heal the sick there,

and say to them, 'The kingdom of God has come near to you.'
(10) But whatever city you enter, and they do not receive you, go

out into its streets and say,

(16) He who hears you hears Me, he who rejects you rejects Me, and he who rejects Me rejects Him who sent Me."
